## SECTION 5: EDUCATION INITIATIVES

### Education Initiatives

Sahara Jan Kalyan Samiti has long recognized that education is the single most powerful instrument for breaking cycles of poverty and marginalization. In 2023-24, the organization deepened its commitment to foundational learning, particularly for children from Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribe (SC/ST) communities in rural Madhya Pradesh.

#### Pre-School Education Program

Pre-school education centers continued to operate in rural areas under the organization's supervision, providing structured foundational learning to children aged 3-6 years. These centers offer a child-friendly environment designed around the following pillars:

- Foundational Learning — structured early literacy and numeracy through play-based activities
- Health Awareness — interactive sessions on hygiene, nutrition, and body care habits for young children
- Field Exposure — organized visits to farms, parks, and local landmarks for real-world learning
- Life Skills Growth — building emotional strength, confidence, and decision-making through structured activities
- Cultural Bonding — sharing stories, songs, and festivals to help children stay rooted in Indian values
- Creative Corners — art, craft, and free-play zones to nurture imagination and self-expression

#### Educational Material Distribution

Before the commencement of each academic session, Sahara distributed textbooks, notebooks, stationery, and school bags to hundreds of children from economically weaker sections. This intervention directly reduces the financial burden on families and ensures no child misses school due to lack of materials.

## Remedial & Supplementary Education

For children who had fallen behind in their studies or were at risk of dropping out, Sahara organized remedial classes led by trained volunteers. Parent-teacher meetings were also convened to create greater community awareness about the importance of education, particularly for girls.

## SECTION 6: HEALTH & NUTRITION PROGRAMS

### Health & Nutrition Programs

Sahara Jan Kalyan Samiti believes that health is a fundamental human right. In 2023-24, the organization intensified its community health programs with a focus on preventive care, maternal and child nutrition, and access to medical services for economically disadvantaged populations.

#### Community Health Camps

Health camps were organized across the operational districts of Madhya Pradesh, providing free medical consultations, health screenings, and medicine distribution to rural and tribal communities who have limited access to formal healthcare.

- Free medical consultations by qualified health professionals
- Screening for common ailments including anaemia, diabetes, and hypertension
- Distribution of essential medicines and supplements
- Referral services for cases requiring advanced hospital care
- Health education and hygiene awareness sessions

#### Child Nutrition Support

Recognizing the alarming levels of child malnutrition in urban slums and rural areas, Sahara worked closely with communities to identify malnourished children under the age of five and provide them with

nutritional support, health monitoring, and family counseling. The organization's ground-level teams conducted door-to-door outreach to ensure no child was missed.

## Bharat Maternal Health & Nutrition Mission

This flagship initiative, led by Sahara Jan Kalyan Samiti, aims to reduce maternal mortality and malnutrition through a multi-pronged community approach in Sagar district and vulnerable areas of Madhya Pradesh. The mission focuses on:

- Upgrading hospital-based maternal and neonatal care systems across urban and semi-urban Madhya Pradesh
- Providing life-saving medical equipment, essential medicines, and support from trained health professionals
- Combating key preventable causes of maternal death: postpartum hemorrhage, eclampsia, and infections
- Delivering nutritional support and early learning access to malnourished and underserved children
- Implementing community training and awareness programs in remote districts

## SECTION 7: WOMEN EMPOWERMENT

### Women Empowerment

Promoting the dignity, health, and economic independence of women is a cornerstone of Sahara Jan Kalyan Samiti's work. In 2023-24, the organization implemented a multi-pronged women empowerment program encompassing menstrual hygiene, skill development, and community organizing.

#### Menstrual Hygiene Program

In many rural communities, menstruation continues to be a taboo subject, leading to unhygienic practices, school absenteeism, and social stigma. Sahara Jan Kalyan Samiti mounted a comprehensive response through:

- Free distribution of sanitary napkins to school-going girls across partner schools
- Menstrual hygiene awareness workshops conducted in schools and communities, breaking social taboos through open community dialogues
- Installation of sanitary pad vending machines in schools and community centers, ensuring stigma-free, affordable, and round-the-clock access to menstrual hygiene products
- Training of girl students and community women as Menstrual Hygiene Champions to sustain awareness beyond the program duration

#### Community Kitchens & Skill Training

Sahara's community kitchen program empowered rural women by training them in preparing nutritious mid-day meals for school children, while simultaneously building their culinary and organizational skills. Tailoring training programs provided additional livelihood skills, helping women achieve economic independence and greater social standing.

#### Self-Help Group (SHG) Support

The organization provided support to women's self-help groups, linking them with financial institutions for microfinance, and offering capacity-building sessions to strengthen their collective voice and economic capabilities.

## SECTION 8: SUPPORT TO DIVYANG (DIFFERENTLY-ABLED)

### Support to Divyang (Differently-Abled)

Inclusion and dignity for persons with disabilities is a non-negotiable commitment for Sahara Jan Kalyan Samiti. In 2023-24, the organization executed one of its most impactful disability support programs through its valued partnership with KONE Elevator India Private Limited.

#### KONE Partnership Program — Assistive Device Distribution

The program was organized with the dual objective of providing greater independence to persons with disabilities in their daily lives, while also strengthening the assistive infrastructure of a leading Mumbai hospital. Tricycles were distributed to enable Divyang individuals to move freely and earn livelihoods, while the wheelchair donation improved patient mobility and care within the hospital.

#### Impact of the Program

- Enhanced mobility and daily independence for 150+ differently-abled individuals
- Supported income generation through improved mobility, enabling some beneficiaries to start small businesses
- Strengthened hospital infrastructure through wheelchair donation to Dr. R.N. Cooper Hospital
- Promoted dignity, confidence, and social inclusion for persons with disabilities
- Demonstrated the power of NGO-Corporate partnership in creating scalable social impact

#### Broader Disability Support Initiatives

- Linkage with government disability welfare schemes for eligible beneficiaries
- Awareness programs in communities to reduce stigma around disability
- Vocational training and livelihood support for differently-abled individuals
- Advocacy for inclusive education and employment opportunities

## SECTION 9: ENVIRONMENTAL CONSERVATION

### Environmental Conservation — 15+ Years of Green Commitment

For more than 15 years, Sahara Jan Kalyan Samiti has been actively involved in tree plantation and long-term environmental maintenance to promote a greener, healthier Sagar and Madhya Pradesh. The organization firmly believes that protecting the environment is not merely a campaign — it is a generational responsibility.

#### Tree Plantation Program

Each year, the organization plants hundreds of trees including fruit-bearing, shade-giving, and native species. Crucially, Sahara's commitment does not end at plantation — the organization maintains an ongoing program of care, watering, protection, and survival monitoring for all trees planted.

- Annual plantation drives in Sagar district — educational institutions, government campuses, rural areas, and public spaces
- Fruit-bearing, shade-giving, and indigenous tree species selected for ecological suitability
- Community members actively engaged as stewards of planted trees, building a sense of ownership
- Environmental awareness campaigns organized alongside plantation activities
- School students engaged in plantation drives to build lifelong environmental values

#### Soil Testing Camps for Sustainable Agriculture

In an innovative extension of its environmental work, Sahara organized on-site soil testing camps in rural areas of Madhya Pradesh. Agricultural scientists and experts demonstrated scientific soil testing techniques to local farmers, helping them understand:

- The health and composition of their agricultural land
- Crop suitability recommendations based on soil analysis
- Guidance on improving soil fertility through organic inputs
- Sustainable farming practices to reduce chemical dependence and soil degradation

## SECTION 10: SOCIAL WELFARE ACTIVITIES

### Social Welfare Activities

Beyond its structured programs, Sahara Jan Kalyan Samiti maintains a continuous commitment to providing immediate relief and social support to the most vulnerable members of the communities it serves.

#### Relief Distribution

- Ration distribution drives in slum areas and economically weaker sections — rice, dal, oil, and essential food items
- Clothes and footwear distribution camps during winter and festive seasons
- Essential household items provided to families during emergencies and crises
- Support to single women-headed households and households with elderly members

#### Community Support Activities

- Health camps with medical consultations organized in collaboration with local hospitals
- Blood donation camps organized to support medical facilities in the region
- Sanitation awareness and drive campaigns in rural and semi-urban communities
- Community awareness programs on social issues — health, gender equality, child rights, and financial literacy

## SECTION 13: SUCCESS STORIES

### Success Stories 2023-24

#### Story 1: Rani's Journey to Learning

Rani, a 10-year-old girl from a Scheduled Caste family in Sagar district, was at serious risk of dropping out of school. Her family could not afford textbooks or school supplies, and without materials, she had fallen far behind her classmates. Through Sahara's educational support program, Rani received a complete set of textbooks, notebooks, stationery, and a school bag. With regular follow-up by the organization's field team and encouragement from her teachers, Rani's attendance improved dramatically. By year-end, she had climbed to among the top performers in her class. She now aspires to become a teacher — and to return to her village and help children like herself.

#### Story 2: New Wheels, New Life — Ram Prasad's Story

Ram Prasad, 45 years old, from Tikamgarh district, had lived with a physical disability that severely limited his mobility. Unable to walk independently, he was dependent on his family for most daily activities, which deeply affected his dignity and self-confidence. Through Sahara's partnership with KONE Elevator India at the distribution event on 11 February 2024, Ram Prasad received a tricycle. Within weeks, he began using the tricycle to travel to the local market where he started a small vending business. For the first time in years, Ram Prasad is earning independently, contributing to his family's income, and — most importantly — living with renewed dignity and purpose.

#### Story 3: Breaking the Silence — Menstrual Hygiene in Panna

In a village in Panna district, adolescent girls regularly missed four to five days of school every month. The reason was simple but deeply embedded in social norms — menstruation was treated as a taboo subject, and no adequate hygiene products or facilities were available in the school. Sahara's team conducted awareness workshops with students, parents, and teachers, openly discussing menstrual health and hygiene. Sanitary napkins were distributed, and a vending machine was installed in the school. Within three months of the program's launch, school attendance among adolescent girls in the target period showed a substantial improvement — with girls reporting greater confidence and no longer feeling ashamed or afraid during menstruation.

#### Story 4: Green Hands — School Students Plant Tomorrow

As part of Sahara's 15+ year environmental conservation program, students from a government school in Sagar participated in a plantation drive in their school grounds. Each student was assigned a tree to plant and then personally responsible for watering and caring for it through the year. The program did more than grow trees — it grew environmental stewardship in young minds. Teachers reported that students began taking home lessons about water conservation and waste management, inspiring their families to adopt greener practices.
